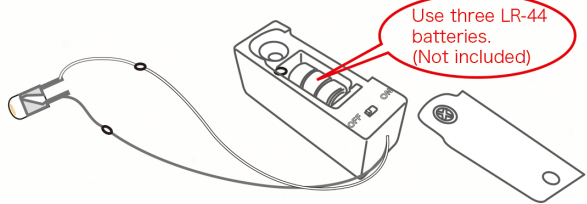
## Cottage in the forest 森のコテージ

### Before beginning

1. An image of the completed model is shown on page 11 as reference while building.
2. Please prepare your own tools for building (scissors, cutter, tweezers, etc.)
3. Please be sure to use the correct materials when cutting to avoid mistakes.
4. Please be aware that the color of the materials may differ from the photos in this manual.
5. An adult should be present if children are building.
6. Please test the operation of the LED light bulbs (A3 and A4) by referring to the image below.



 DO NOT connect the cords directly to the batteries.



Lighting tests require connecting to the power switch (A2). Please prepare batteries and a screw driver.  
Connect the cords with the same colors.

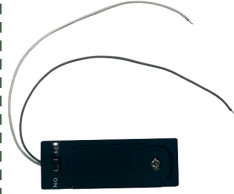
### Caution

DO NOT use any other switch besides the power switch included. Also, DO NOT plug any of the cords into power outlets.

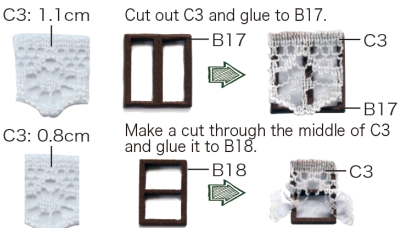
## Cottage

1 Cut out the D parts and glue them to the B parts.



2 Make the wall-4

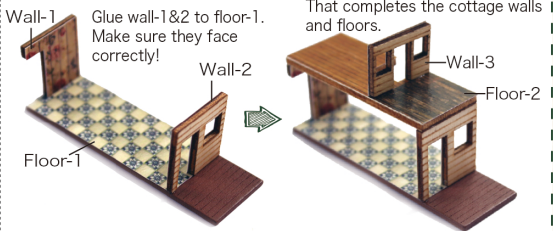


Glue B17 and B18 which glued C3 to D10.

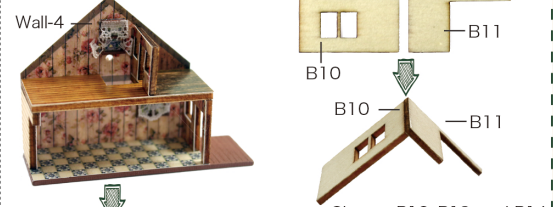


The completed wall-4.

3 Make the cottage foundation



Glue the cottage walls and floors to wall-4. Glue B10 to B11 and make the roof.

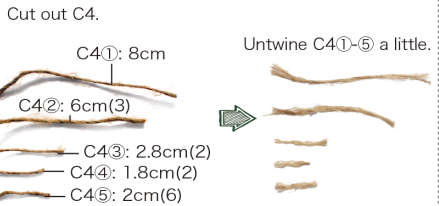


Glue the roof to wall-4. Glue on B12, B13, and B14.

4 Complete the cottage



Glue the untwined C4 to the cottage's roof.



The completed cottage.

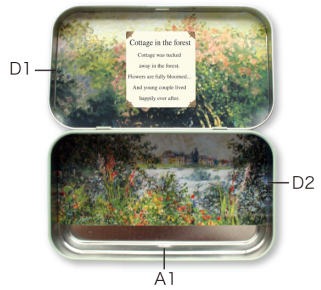
# Background and case

## 1 Prepare the case.



Glue D1 and D2 to A1.



## 2 Install the LED light bulbs (string of lights)

Temporarily place in the building, as in the image, and adjust the positioning of A4 so that light comes in from skylights.



Cottage

Before gluing in, use A2 to test if the lights turn on.

## 3 Make the nameplate



Glue D3 to B4.

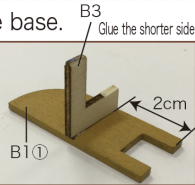


Glue it to B1②. Make a long side the top!



## 4 Make the base.

Glue B3 to B1① and B1③ each.



Similarly, glue B3 to B1③ as well.

## 5 Attach the name plate



Glue B1③ to the bottom-right corner of A1. At this time, install A2 and the name plate like in the image without gluing together, and make sure the name plate fits in properly without being too loose.



Glue B1① to the bottom-left corner of A1.

## 6 Complete the background and case

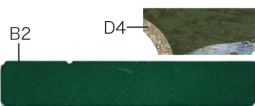
Be careful that the widths of B1①,②,③ are not too wide or else the name plate will fall forwards!

# Ground

Glue D4 to B2.



Cut out C1①-③, C2① and C2② with the pattern papers (separate sheet).



Glue on C1①, ② and ③.

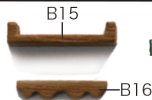
Glue C2①&② on top of it.



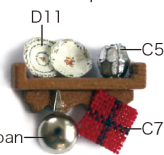
The completed ground.

### Flying pan

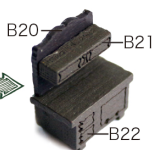
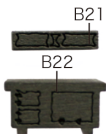
Cut off the three spikes of C6 and bend the remaining spike to make a frying pan.

Cut C7 into 0.4 x 0.4cm.

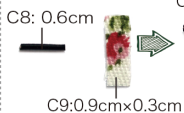


The completed display shelf.

Glue together each of the parts.

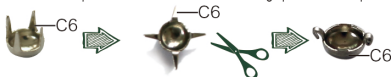


### Pan-1

Cut off the two spikes of C6 and bend the remaining spikes to make pan-1.

### Pan-2

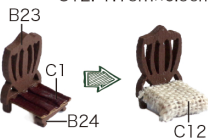
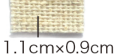
Cut off the two spikes of C6 and bend the remaining spikes to make pan-2.

Cut C1 into 0.7x0.7cm.

※The patterns are on separate sheets of paper.

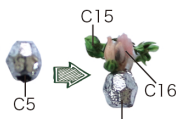
Cut out C7① with the pattern papers, and glue. Refine the shape of C7①.

### Vase



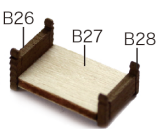
### Fruits

Fold C9 along the dotted line to make the pillow.



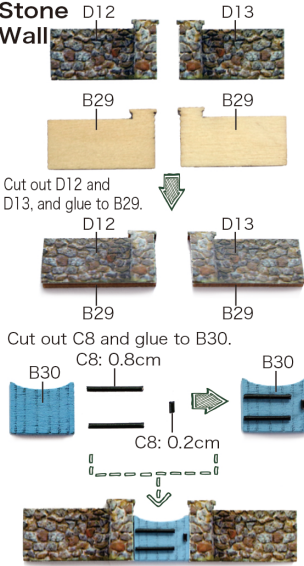

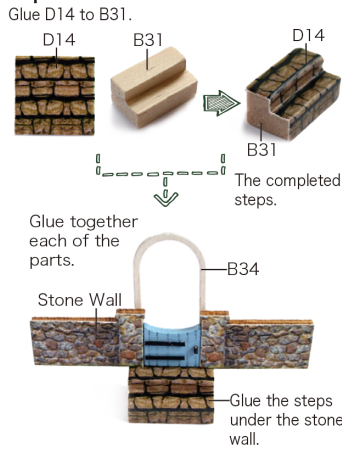

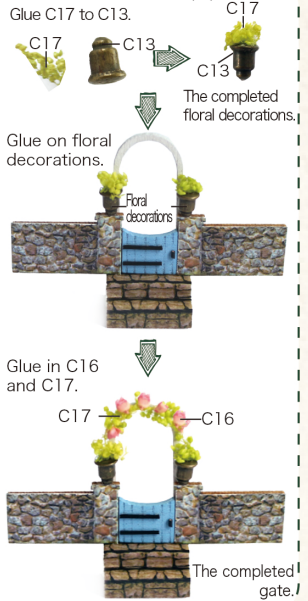

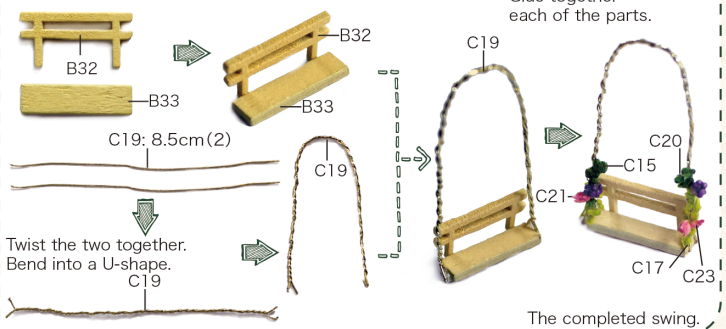


# Flower and Berries

## Tree-1

Cut out C1⑤ and C18② with the pattern papers. Be careful which way the crinkles face.

Roll up C1⑤, and cover and glue C18② over the top.

Bend it to look like a tree. Cut out a part to make the roots.



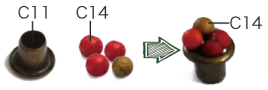
## Tree-2

Cut out C1④ and C18① with the pattern papers. Be careful which way the crinkles face.

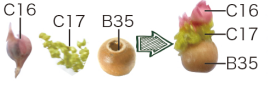
Roll up C1④, and cover and glue C18① over the top. Bend it to look like a tree.



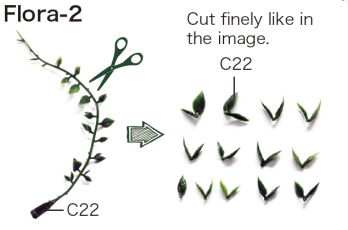
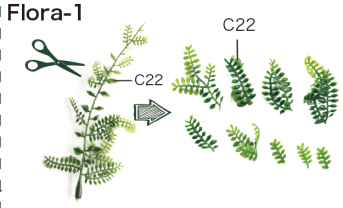

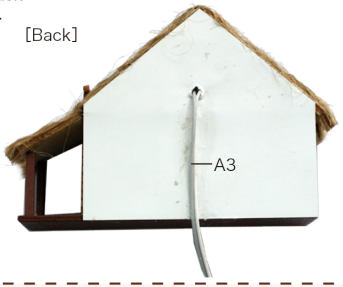

## Lighting of the cottage



Bring the A3 cord out the back from the hole in the cottage.

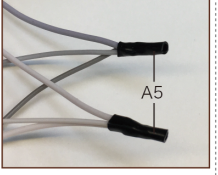
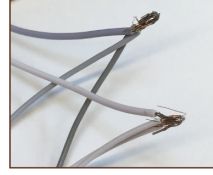


## Installing and connecting the power switch

### 1 Connect the cords

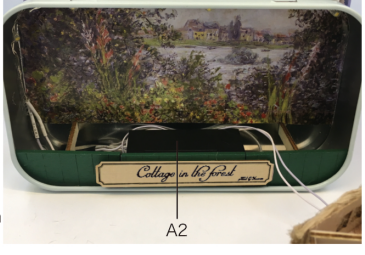
Connect the A2, A3 and A4 cords by their same colors.

Cover with a 1 cm-cut piece of A5, and use a hair-dryer to shrink it with heat.



### 2 Installing and arranging the power box

Install A2 without gluing, as in the image, and arrange the cords. Keep the cords to the left side as much as possible and pass them through the back of A2. Do not pass the cords through the top, bottom or front of A2.

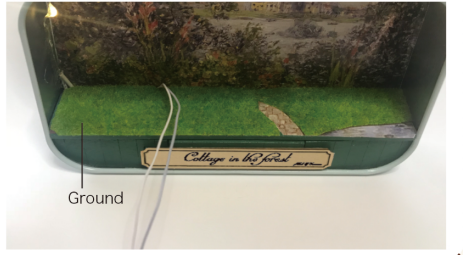


### 3 Run an electrical current test

Temporarily place in the ground without gluing it, and switch on the power to test the electrical current.

### 4 Put in the ground

Glue the ground into the case. At this time, set each cord through its designated dent.

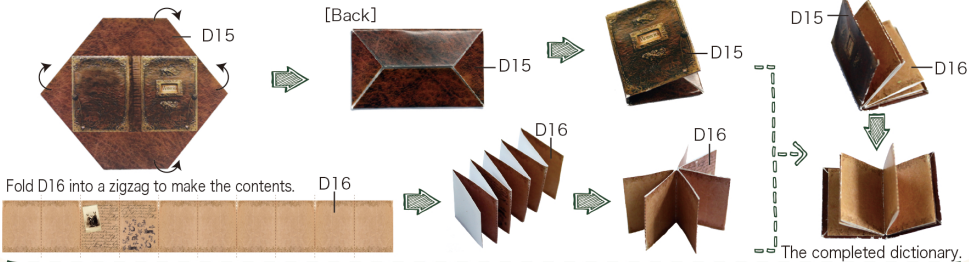


# Dictionary

Fold D15 like in the image to make the cover.

Glue the contents to the cover.

# Completing the cottage in the forest

## 1 Put in the cottage

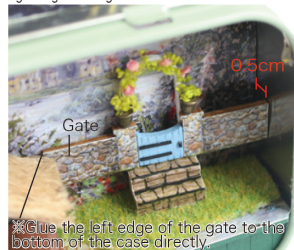
Glue the cottage into the case.

Put the cottage in the case from a head of. Spread out the A3 cords over the back of the cottage so that they don't overlap each other.



## 2 Make the garden

Glue in the gate and then leave 0.5 cm between the right edge of the gate and the bottom of the case.

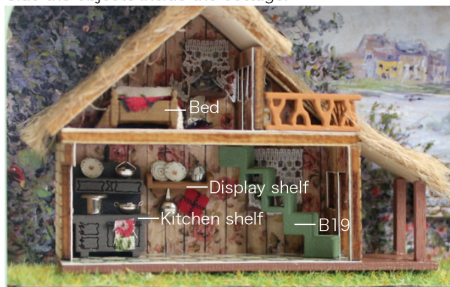


Glue in tree-1&2 and the swing.



## 3 Make the cottage

Glue the objects inside the cottage.



Glue the flora around the cottage.



## 4 Decorate around the cottage with the flora and flagstones

Glue in the finely cut flora like in the image. Glue in flowers and berries around the roof and column too.



## 5 Complete the cottage in the forest

Glue the dictionary, D17 and D18 to the inside of the case's lid.



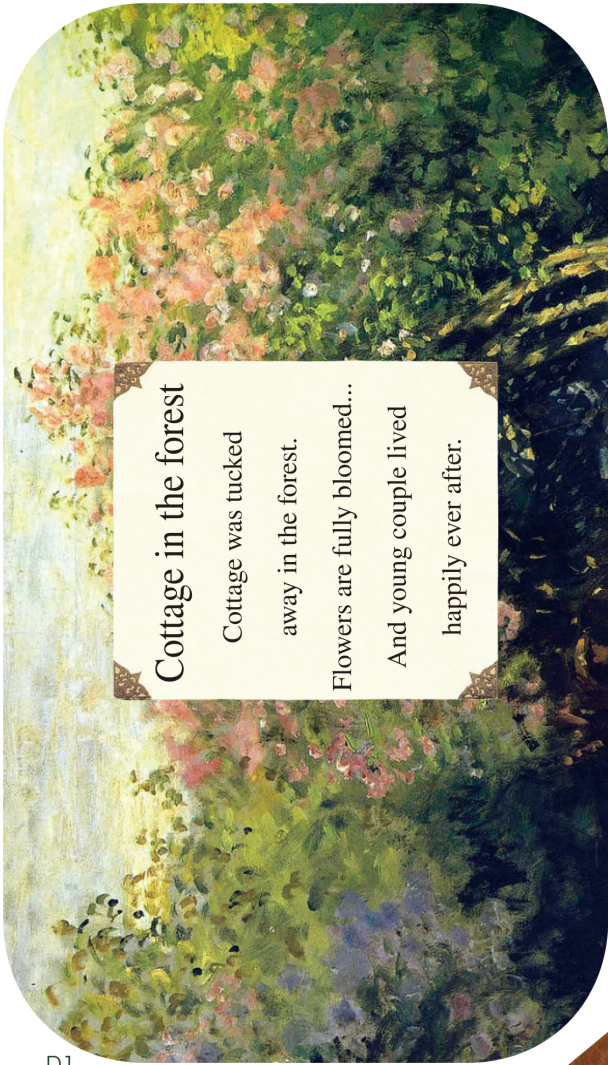
