






Before beginning to make…

- 1. Please prepare your own tools for building (needle, scissors, cutter, tweezers, etc.)
- 2. Please be sure to use the correct materials when cutting to avoid mistakes.
- 3. By cutting the pattern papers first the corresponding numbers may be cut off, so please be careful.
- 4. Please be aware that the color of the materials may differ from the photos in this manual.
- 5. An adult should be present if children are building.
- 6. For best results in preparing the fabric patterns, first place the paper on the fabric and draw a line around it to assist cutting.
- 7. How to perform the running stitch Insert the needle from 1, take it out of 2, insert from 3, and take it out of 4.Repeat this.


Please take proper care in handling the needle.





8. Please test the operation of the LED light bulbs (B5) by referring to the image below.







Lighting tests require connecting to the bottom of the pedestal of the B2 pedestal set. Please prepare batteries and a screw driver.Connect the cords with the same colors.

Warning DO NOT plug any of the cords into power outlets.





Gift Box

Using Gift Box(1)(2)&(3) of the C32 pattern paper, cut C32, curl it around to match B1-6, and glue it.





Glue B1-7 to the bottom part of the side, and glue B1-8 to the top part.



That completes the Gift Box.





 Cut out B1-1 to B1-8 with the pattern papers.

Candy Plate

Using the pattern papers, cut out C31 and B1-15 together and glue them. Glue C5 around the edge.

Glue C8 to B1-15's underside.



Glue on B13

Glue three candies of 1.2cm to B13.







• Glue together B11 and C1. Make six candies. Glue on two balls of C4 and the candy.








That completes the candy plate.

Candy Stand



Glue B1-9 to the top part of Gift Box3.






Glue three candies inside C25.












That completes the candy stand.





Cut out C34 with the pattern papers and glue in the center

Cake A Cut B9 into four 3mm-thick pieces. Cut out C34 with the pattern paper and glue in the center of the silver surface. Bundle it up with C34 and glue on C6.



of the gold surface. Bundle it up with C34 and glue on C6.

Cut B10 into four 3mm-thick pieces.

Cake B

C1:1.2cm — C4 (5)

Cut C1 into five 1.2cm-thick pieces. Cut five pairs of balls

from C4. Glue C1 and C20 together. Glue C4 to C20.

C34(Surface is gold) That completes the cake A(4) That completes the cake B(4)

That completes the Lolly Pop Chocolates(5)

That completes the cake stand.


Mesh Ribbon

· Cut out C27 with the pattern paper. With a double strand, sew a running stitch through the middle of C27.



Stitch through the squeezed part two to three times.

Just before the thread knot, pass the needle between the threads.



Lastly make a French knot to keep the ribbon shape.




Tighten the thread to make the

Table

Glue A4 in the center of A3. That completes the table base.



 Similarly, on the opposite side, layer and glue the side faces of the table cloth.




Cut out C29 with the pattern paper, and glue to the table base.



 Similarly, also glue the sides of the table's other side.



. Glue the triangular parts to the side faces of the table cloth.



That completes the table.



Table Ornaments


Cut out C30 with the pattern paper, and glue onto the table.



 Cut off 10cm of C39, tie it in a bow, and glue it on top of the mesh ribbon.

C39:10cm

Ut C37 into four pieces of 7cm, and glue them to the edge of the table cloth.





Mesh ribbon



Ut off three 10cm strands of C40, tie them each in a bow, and glue one on the opposite side of the table, and the other two each on the short-end sides of the table.



C40:10cm

Ut off single balls from C4 to glue to C37. When gluing, leave two loops between each one.









That completes the table ornaments.

Chocolate Stand

Glue each part to Gift Box①.

Chocolate balls


 Cut out six C34 with the pattern paper, and wrap up a C21 with each of them.

Cut off any extra part and wrap it up. That completes six chocolate balls.



Glue C11 and C12 together. That


Plate for chocolates







That completes the chocolates stand.



 Using the pattern papers, glue the cake plates and B1-14 to C31. That completes eight cake plates.

Higher stage

Glue on the Lolly Pop Chocolates.

Middle stage



Cut out B1-18 with the pattern paper to make the Card Stand.



Lower stage

Glue on the Cake Bs to the cake plates and glue them to the lower stage.



Glue on each of the parts.



That completes the table setting.

Bouquet

 Cut out C26 with the pattern paper. Fold C26 like an accordion with 1cm intervals, fold it in two across the middle, and pass through C2.



Glue on two each of C17, C18 and C19.

and eight of the singularly-cut C5.

Make the length of both sides of C2 equal and twist it together, then pass through and glue on C16.



Cut off 2cm from C40, bend it and glue the two edges together. Make six.



Glue the six C40s to the underside of C26.



Glue four C16s to C26.



On the underside, cut C2 to an appropriate length.









That completes the bouquet.



Wedding Dress







 Wrap the dress skirt around the waist of B15 and sew its edges together.
 Glue both edges of the dress skirt.



Pull the thread to squeeze it. That completes the dress skirt.



• Cut the protruding parts of the dress skirt.



That completes the wedding dress.

Wedding Dress Ornaments 🐇

Ribbons (4)

Cut C40 into four 3cm pieces.



Wind C40 around a pen or similar object and glue its edges together.
Cut off 3cm of C2 and pass Take it off the pen and fold into two. it through the fold of C40.



■ Wind C2 around once ■ Cut off the extra parts of C2. That completes the ribbons (4).











 Matching where the embroidered flowers are on the dress, glue on C13 alternately at higher positions and lower positions like in the image. (Total 8 pieces)

Glue the ribbons on top of the lower-positioned C13s. (Total 4 pieces)

Mesh ribbon

 Cut out C28 with the C28 pattern paper to make the mesh ribbon.



* For how to make the mesh ribbon. refer to page 6.

The completed mesh ribbon.

Glue the C28 mesh ribbon to the back of the dress skirt.



C13 Ribbons Ribbons -C13

 Glue C4 (in pairs of balls) onto the dress skirt aligned with the rise and fall of its hem. (Total 15 pairs)

Glue C4 (singular balls) in the center of the dress skirt's flower patterns. (Total 4 pieces)



Cut off 10cm of C40 and tie it in a bow. Glue C4 (7cm) and C40 to the mesh ribbon.



Glue C7 around the neck, and glue C24 on to it at the front. Cut off 6cm of C38 and glue it around the waist. Cut off any extra part.

Cut a part of the C7 periphery and cut out the whole inside part.


Welcome Board

Archway




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That completes the archway

Pedestal Setting

Pass the cords for the archway through the holes in the pedestal and glue in the archway and table.



Lightly pull the cords from under the pedestal, and glue on the wedding dress.







Pass the lantern cords through the holes in the pedestal, and glue on the lantern and its cords.

Pass the welcome board's cords through the same hole as for the lantern, and apply glue to the three legs of the board.

Glue in the welcome board.







Glue the bouquet in front of the welcome board.










Cord Wiring

 Gather together the B5 cords by color, and connect them to the B2 cords of the same color. Cut off 2cm pieces of B6 to wrap around the connected areas.



Bring together the two pedestal parts so the screw hole of the lower pedestal with a circle sign matches the No. 4 screw hole of the upper pedestal. Fasten the screws in four places of the pedestal.







Power switch

Uses three size-AAA batteries.

If using batteries, please turn on/off with the power switch.

microUSB port (USB Micro-B)

Connect main unit and external power device with a USB port with microUSB cable. Input voltage/Current:DC5V/1~2.4A
